





SYMBOL OF CHRIST

In John 1:29, John the Baptist describes Jesus Christ as the “Lamb of God”. Like a lamb, Jesus was clean and pure, so God showed His love for us by allowing His Son to be sacrificed for the mistakes that we all make and sadness we feel.

CONTINUED

In Old Testament times before Jesus lived on the earth, people sacrificed lambs to help them understand that someday God would sacrifice His own Son (read John 3:16). Because Jesus died for us, we can be forgiven and return to live with God and Jesus again someday.

HANDMADE COTTON LAMB

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- white & black paper
- cotton balls
- glue
- scissors
- white crayon
- 2 googly eyes




INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Trace and cut out the lamb's body and head.
- 2 Cover the lamb's body with glue.
- 3 Cover the rest of the lamb's body with cotton balls.
- 4 Glue the lamb's head onto the body (on top of the cotton balls).
- 5 Glue the googly eyes on the head.
- 6 Cut a small triangle out of a black construction paper and glue it to the face as a nose.


Pull apart the cotton balls to make them fluffy (:




body (trace on
